

ORDINANCE O-09-2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSBORO, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING THE DESIGNATED ALLEYWAY, COMMONLY CALLED "JEWELL STREET" AS A DESIGNATED STREET, NAMING THE STREET "JEWELL STREET"; REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksboro, Texas, as a Type A General-Law Municipality, has exclusive control over the highways, streets, and alleys of the municipality (Transportation Code, Chapter 311); and

WHEREAS, the Lindsey Addition, Block 12, was approved and adopted by the City of Jacksboro, as a residentially zoned area; and

WHEREAS, the current "alleyway", in the Lindsey Addition, Block 12, connecting N. 6th Street and N. 5th Street, South of W. Thompson Street and North of W. College Street, of the City of Jacksboro has been commonly referred to as "Jewell Street"; and

WHEREAS, new construction has begun with the need to address the property as being on "Jewell Street" for the purposes of 911 addressing and emergency services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that there is a need to officially designate this alleyway as a street, as it has been commonly referred to, and name said street "Jewell Street".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSBORO, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. That the above recitals are hereby found to be true, correct and incorporated here for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Jacksboro, Texas authorizes the designation of the alleyway described above to be changed and designated as a street.

SECTION 3. The City Council of the City of Jacksboro, Texas, authorizes the naming of "Jewell Street" as the street in the Lindsey Addition, Block 12, connecting N. 6th Street and N. 5th Street, South of W. Thompson Street and North of W. College Street. A copy of the map is attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit A".

SECTION 4. REPEALING CONFLICTS.


All ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, subsection, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall continue in effect as if the invalid portion had never been included.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. The Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage.

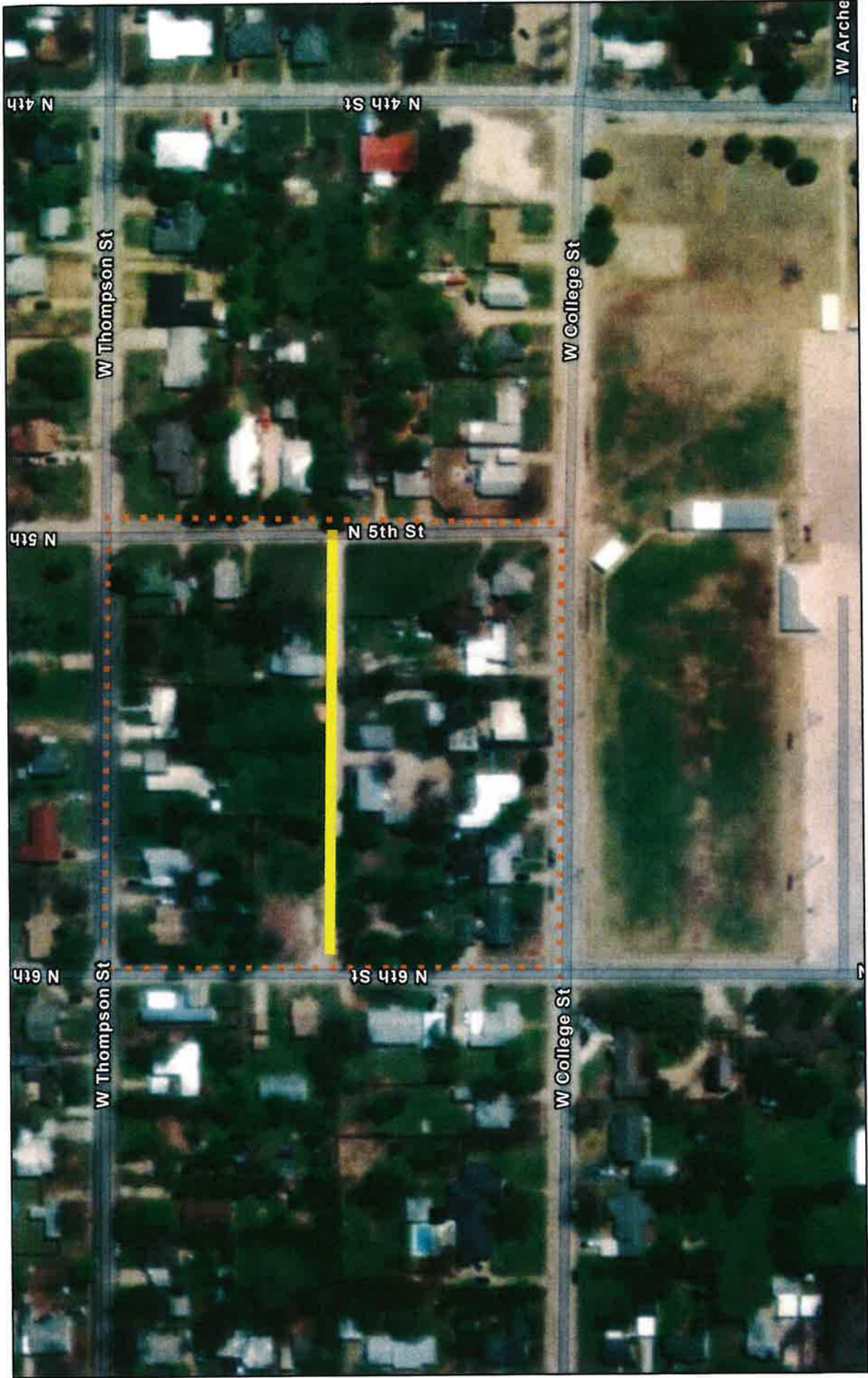
